Title: Healthcare policy and regulations to ensure healthcare and alternative healthcare for advanced healthcare and patient's safety

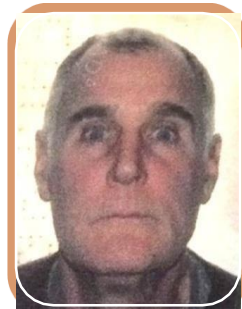
Biography

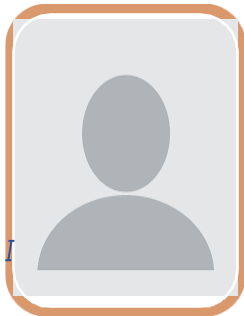

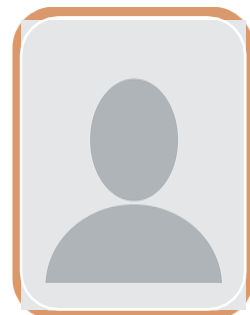

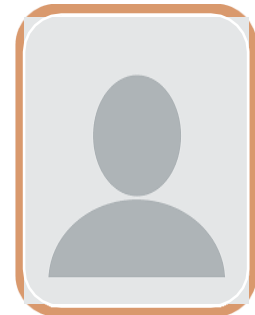
